CWQA'S 50TH ANNIVERSARY!

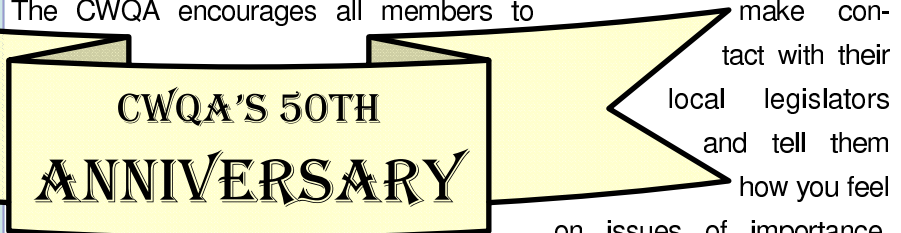

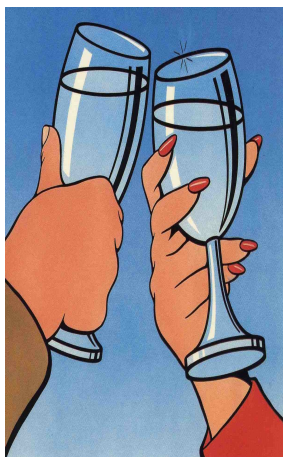
